To earn credit with AVSA, you should bring your current AVSA membership card, proof of three blue ribbons (one may be from Design or other Gesneriad classes), plus a copy of the AVSA Handbook for Growers, Exhibitors and Judges, 2011 edition with all additions and corrections listed in the African Violet Magazine. A study guide will be sent to all registrants prior to the class advising which areas will be covered and what to study.
